

Senate Budget Committee

February 3, 2003 Report

The Senate Budget Committee met once since the last Senate meeting in January.

The committee continued discussion on the use of Social Security Numbers on campus but decided this topic was more appropriate to the Senate Faculty Welfare Committee so the chair sent a memo to a member of this committee along with some information collected on the topic.

The committee continued discussion of the use of advising funds for faculty salary enhancement. The chair shared reactions from department chairs around campus. Further action was not taken as word reached the committee that these funds had already been reallocated. The chair was directed to confirm this before proceeding.

The committee is hosting a Budget Forum on Tuesday, February 11, 2003 in the Teaching Learning Center of Keen Johnson Building. An email announcement has been distributed to faculty and staff.

The committee will meet later in February to consider the Athletic budget.
