PROPOSAL:

Beginning with the Fall 2003 semester, students transferring to EKV with an Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, or Associate of Applied Sciences, and Associate of Science in Nursing degree should be considered proficient in the three basic skill areas of English (writing), mathematics, and reading.

JUSTIFICATION:

Students with AA, AS, or AAS degrees typically attended community colleges or institutions of higher education where the basic skill area proficiencies were needed to acquire the degree. Therefore, these students should be considered developmentally proficient in all basic skill areas.
