

Recommended Changes for Extended Campuses and Centers

1. Appoint a University level standing committee for extended campuses.
2. Delegate authority to one person to be over the extended campuses.
3. Ask the faculty senate to amend the faculty handbook to support these recommendations.
4. Create revenue sharing for departments that participate in delivering courses to extended campuses and centers to fund faculty incentives.
5. Empower deans and department chairs to use a variety of incentives to motivate faculty to provide instruction at the extended campuses.
6. Establish clear protocols and lines of communication and reporting between the extended campus administration, extended campus faculty, academic deans, general education, the transfer center, and home departments.
7. Create articulation agreements with community colleges to create new facilities and shared degree programs.
8. Create flexible scheduling of classes to meet the needs of non-traditional students.
9. Invest in distance education infrastructure to expand capacity.
10. Provide new faculty lines for departments that attract 20 new FTE students to their programs.
11. Deliver full degree programs and general education courses, graduate and undergraduate, at extended campuses.
