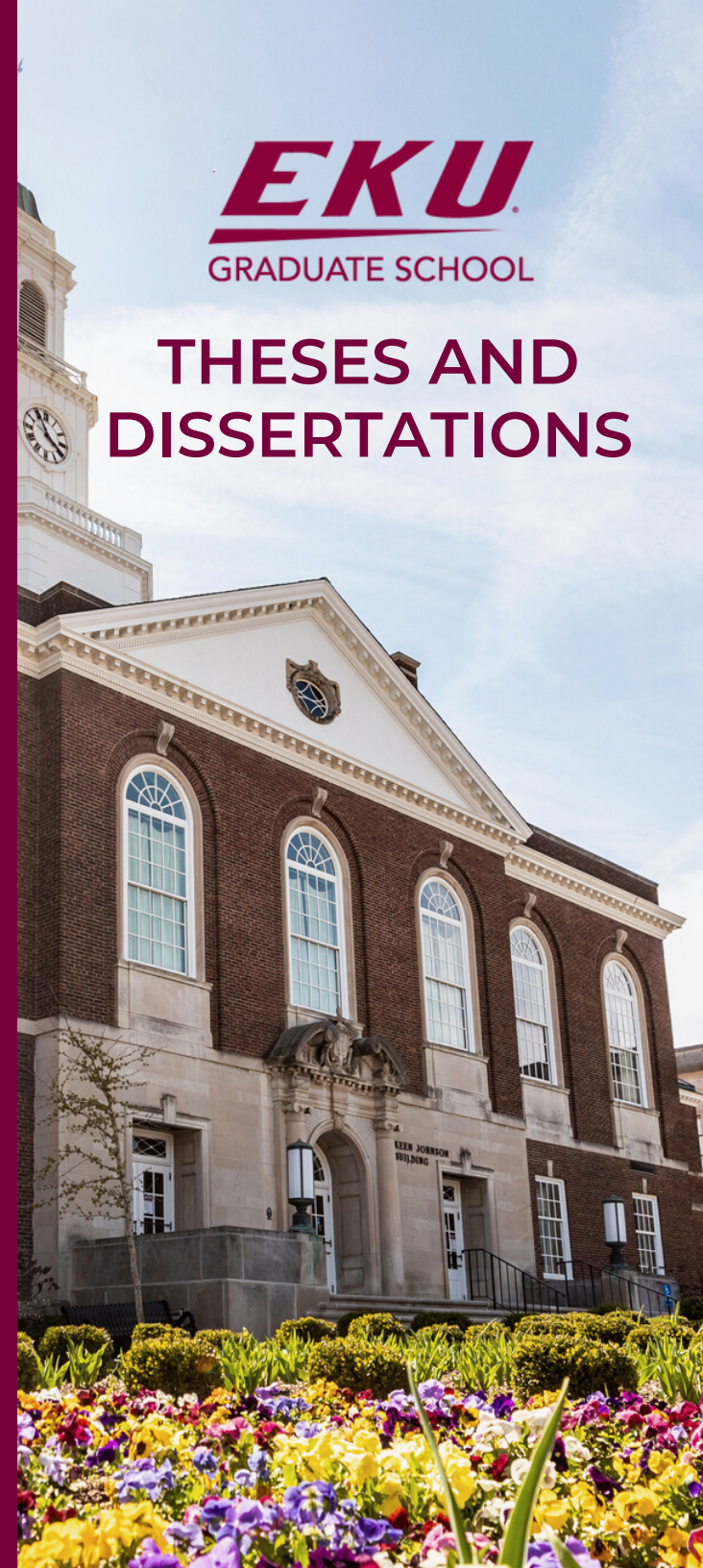

SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Electronic theses and dissertations (ETDs) will be published with ProQuest UMI and also in ECU's institutional repository. Electronic theses and dissertations will be available via the internet.

The process for submission and acceptance of electronic theses and dissertations is as follows:

Step 1: Candidates who have successfully completed their defense should complete the ETD Submission form and the Permission to Use form and email it to graduateschooletd@ecu.edu. Forms are located at: gradschool.ecu.edu/thesis-guidelines

Step 2: The Chair of the thesis/dissertation committee should email an electronic version of the thesis or dissertation, along with the committee signature form, to graduateschooletd@ecu.edu

Step 3: Candidates will be notified through their ECU email with instructions to enter biographical information into the ProQuest website

Step 4: Candidates will be notified through their ECU email for formatting changes required before final publication

DEADLINES

- April 11th: Submission deadline for Spring degree candidates
- July 2nd: Submission deadline for Summer degree candidates
- November 10th: Submission deadline for Fall degree candidates
