Gifts from alumni and friends of Eastern Kentucky University have paid-in-full for the Veterans Memorial. Additional funds of \$10,000 have been donated that has allowed for the creation of an endowment fund by the ROTC Alumni Chapter and Eastern Kentucky University to provide perpetual support for the Veterans Memorial. The earnings from this endowed fund will be used at the sole discretion of the ECU ROTC Alumni Chapter or any way the donor sees fit, so long as the funds are used for the support, maintenance and general upkeep of the Veterans Memorial.

Army 4 Year Scholarships EKU Room and Board Scholarships GRFD Scholarships, SMP

This has been a great year for ECU. We have the largest incoming Freshman class in decades. In years past we have only been allocated four 4 year scholarships. This year ECU has **21 Freshman** on 4 year scholarships. Next year is expected to be even better. **ECU will now award room and board scholarships to all Army ROTC 4 year scholarship winners.** We also have a GRFD scholarship program where Cadets are guaranteed Reserve/Guard Duty and the Simultaneous Membership Program (SMP) where Cadets serve in the National Guard or Army Reserve and are in ROTC at the same time, the Guard or Reserve pay 100% tuition and the Cadets are non-deployable.

Taylor S. Oney

I Ralph Newman and Jim Montgomery proposed the ROTC Alumni Chapter and the ROTC Military Science Department establish an ROTC Cadet Leadership Award to be named the First Lieutenant John B. Hanlon Leadership Award. The award will be presented annually during the Military Ball to a Junior or Senior Cadet nominated by his or her peers, who demonstrates exceptional qualities of leadership in the Corps of Cadets, the University, and in the community. John B. Hanlon, a 1964 graduate of ECU served in Viet Nam where on 3 November, 1965, he suffered severe wounds and for his heroic actions that day was awarded the Silver Star. John has overcome the trauma of his wounds and thirty six major operations to have a distinguished career with the Veteran's Administration in Memphis, TN, and in 2002 was selected as an Outstanding Alumnus of Eastern Kentucky University. This ROTC leadership award is also a reminder to students, faculty, alumni, and the community of sacrifices made by graduates of Eastern Kentucky University who have served with bravery and distinction in the Armed Forces of the United States. The first John Hanlon Leadership Award was presented to Cadet Brian Riggs, Powell County, KY, February 16, 2007. This year's recipient was Taylor S. Oney, pictured above and was presented on February 15, 2008.
