The G2G Program identifies Enlisted Soldiers in the Regular Army (RA) with officer potential and enables them, through ROTC, to attend college, complete Army Officer Commissioning requirements, and compete for officer assignments.







- Active Duty Option (ADO) (2 year program)
- Scholarship (2, 3, 4 year program)
- Hip Pocket Scholarship (2, 3, 4 year program)
- ➢ Non-scholarship Option (2 year program)







- Centralized Selection Board
- Remain on active status maintaining pay, benefits, and allowances
- Can use GI bill, Grants, Loans (no Tuition Assistance)
- Assigned to Student Detachment at Fort Jackson, SC. Early reporting is NOT authorized
- Must have 4 semesters/6 quarters remaining toward first Bachelor's or Master's degree

Competitive: currently limited to 300 slots per year

Centralized Selection Board

- Soldier is discharged from the Army forfeits all pay, benefits and allowances (Must Contract)
- ➤ Tuition or Room and Board
- Can use GI Bill/grants/other scholarships
- > No different than a High School Scholarship





No centralized scholarship board

- Division/Corps CGs are allotted 1 to 5 scholarships annually
- Compete against other Soldiers from the local command
- ➢All eligibility criteria apply

On-line application to include the CG nomination memo must be completed and uploaded no later than 1 APR.





- Simultaneous Membership Program (SMP)
- ≻Can use GI Bill
- Guaranteed Reserve Forces Duty (GRFD) Scholarship, if under 31 years of age at commission
- Non-scholarship is a contract between the applicant and the school
- Must contract prior to separation

- Scholarship < 31 by 31 Dec of the year of commissioning (No Waivers)
- ADO/Nonscholarship < 30 years old at the projected time of commission (Waivers are authorized)
- ➢GT Score: 110 (No Waivers)
- ➤ Cumulative GPA of 2.5 (Waivers are authorized)
- Pass APFT <6 Months of Application (No Waivers)</p>
- Meet height/ weight standards (No Waivers)
- Chain of Command favorable recommendations (No Waivers)
- ➢ US Citizen (No Waivers)
- ➢ Not a conscientious objector (No Waivers)
- Eligible to re-enlist (No Waivers)





- PMS Letter of Acceptance (No Waivers)
- Favorable Clearance Investigation approved or initiated (No Waivers)
- SAT/ ACT minimum 1000/19 (Waivers for score authorized)
- Cannot have been convicted of a Domestic Violence Crime (Lautenberg Amendment) (No Waivers)
- No arrests, indictments, or convictions by a civil court for other than minor traffic violations (Waiverable)
- Minimum of 2 years Active Duty (Waiverable)
- Must meet Training Service Obligation (Waiverable)
- Qualified/Waiver Granted DODMERB Medical Exam IAW AR 40-501



Eligibility (Cont.)

- With Dependents
 - No more than three to include spouse (Waiverable)
 - Sole parent with custody (Waiverable)
 - Spouse in Armed Forces/Dual Military with dependent under the age of 18 (Waiverable)
 - Responsible for child support (Waiverable)

- Civil Conviction (CG Approval)/TIS/TSO waivers need to be submitted ASAP
- All other waivers will be addressed AFTER board selection





WAIVERS APPROVED AT ROTC BDE COMMANDER LEVEL

Waiver Type: **AGE** (30-32 at Time of Commission), **DEPENDENCY** (Married with more than 3 dependents, Divorced without custody, Dual Military), **RE-ENROLLMENT**, **CIVIL CONVICTION** (Any conviction that sentence consisted of a fine only)







WAIVERS APPROVED AT USACC CG LEVEL

Leaders for Life

Waiver Type: **ACT/SAT, ACTIVE FEDERAL SERVICE** (+10 years at time of Commission), **AGE** (33-39 at Time of Commission), **DEPENDENCY** (Single parent, Divorced with Joint Custody), **GPA, CIVIL CONVICTION** (Any adverse disposition that included a sentence of more than fine)

WAIVER APPROVED AT HQDA LEVEL

Waiver Type: AGE (40-42 at time of Commissioning)

Applicant Provides PGM of Choice with DA FORM 4187 Template

PGM of Choice assists applicant with DA FORM 4187, Obtains PMS Endorsement, then Forwards to BDE HQ

BDE HQ Obtains BDE CDR's Endorsement then returns to PGM of Choice

PGM of Choice returns completed DA Form 4187 to G2G Applicant NLT 3/15/20XX



USACC (RMID), uploads document and notifies applicant of adjudication HQDA adjudicates approval/disapproval and returns memo to USACC (RMID) USACC (RMID) validates/rejects DA Form 4187, obtains CG's Endorsement, and forwards to HQDA G2G Applicant uploads completed DA Form 4187 to his or her online application NLT 3/15/20XX





WAIVERS APPROVED AT HRC LEVEL Leaders for Life Waiver: Training Service Obligation, Time In Service (between 18-23 months at program start date)

> Applicant Uploads DA Form 4187 signed by his/her BN Level Commander NLT 3/15/20XX



USACC (RMID) validates/rejects DA FORM 4187, forwards to HRC

➡

USACC (RMID) uploads final document to online application, and informs applicant of adjudication

HRC provides approval/disapproval memo and returns to USACC (RMID)

The Army Green to Gold Program is designed to offer Enlisted Soldiers in the Army the opportunity to earn a commission as Army Officers. This program offers enlisted Soldiers several unique ways to earn a baccalaureate or graduate degree:

- Green to Gold Scholarship Option For Soldiers who are considering leaving Active Duty to attend college while
 receiving full tuition or room and board (capped), flat rate book payment and a monthly stipend.
- Green to Gold Active Duty Option For Soldiers who want to remain on Active Duty and attend college.
- Green to Gold Non-Scholarship For Soldiers who are considering leaving Active Duty to attend college while
 receiving a monthly stipend.
