Young Adults between 18 and 24 are eligible for Arbor Youth's services if they are homeless. For the program, young adults staying with friends or relatives are not usually eligible, but each case is assessed individually. Arbor Youth Services provides a wide range of key services for homeless young adults ages 18-24. They operate under a "Housing First" framework, so they do not require their clients to be drug free before they are assisted them with housing. Clients are sorted into one program or the other based on their need. Case management is also provided to every client.
