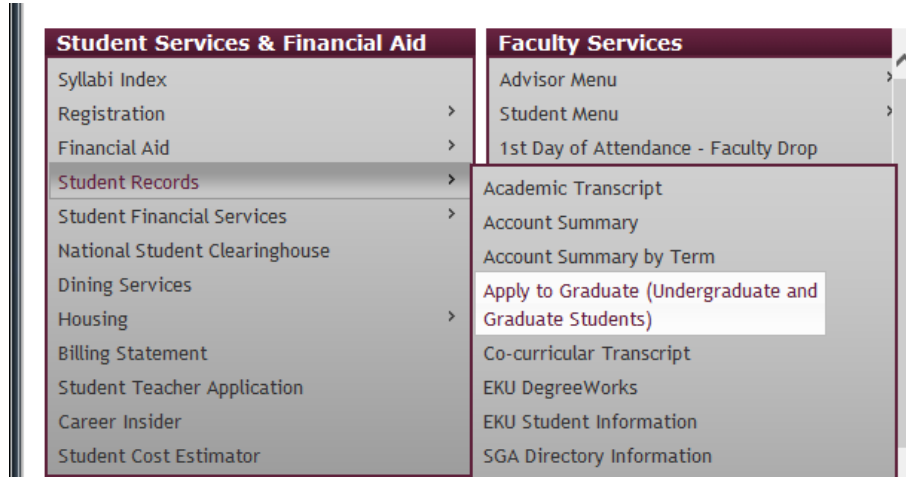


EKU Direct Graduation Application FAQs

1. Where do I apply?

After logging into ECU Direct, select “Student Services & Financial Aid”, “Student Records” and “Apply to Graduate”.



2. Completing a Thesis or Dissertation?

A popup question will display after choosing your curriculum. “Yes” should only be chosen if you are truly completing a Thesis/Dissertation.

Exit requirement types such as; Research Project, Capstone, Comprehensive Exams, Internships, etc. should select “No”.

3. Pursuing more than one degree program?

A student pursuing both a Masters, Specialist or Doctoral degree AND a University Certificate will need to apply once for each program. Any graduation fees or late fees will apply to each application.

4. How much does it cost to graduate?

University Certificate - \$20

Masters/Specialist/Doctorate - \$55

Late Fees (**After Deadline*) - \$50 or \$100 depending on application submission date.

5. What are the eligibility rules to apply for graduation?

- **Masters/Specialist/Doctoral degree** – Earned at least 12 graduate level credits with a cumulative GPA of 2.0* or higher.
- **University Certificate** – Earned at least 3 graduate level credits with a cumulative GPA of 2.0* or higher.

**Students must have a cumulative 3.0 at the end of the term they plan to graduate in order to earn their degree.*

6. Why can't I select a certain term to graduate?

The application is set up for one calendar year at a time. Example- Fall 2016 will become available after November 30, 2015. No applications will be available for the term after the deadlines below:

- **Spring** – Last day to apply is April 30
- **Summer** – Last day to apply is July 31
- **Fall** – Last day to apply is November 30
