

Ralph W. Whalin Scholarship

The Ralph W. Whalin Scholarship is to be granted annually to a junior in the Department of Applied Engineering and Technology who demonstrates exceptional character, scholarship, leadership, professionalism, cooperativeness and industry as selected by a committee.

Qualifications

To be considered for the scholarship, the applicant *must*:

- Be enrolled as a full-time student in the Department of Applied Engineering and Technology at Eastern Kentucky University;
- Must have at least 3 semesters remaining before the completion of a degree in the Department of Applied Engineering and Technology at the time of the Scholarship Award; and
- Have an overall GPA of 3.0 or above.

Method of Selection

The recipient(s) will be selected on a competitive basis by the Department of Applied Engineering and Technology Scholarship committee. The committee will work in cooperation with the University's Scholarship Office and the Office of Financial Affairs in awarding the scholarship.

Conditions of Scholarship

The scholarship recipient must maintain a 3.00 GPA and make normal progress toward a degree in the Department of Applied Engineering and Technology. Normal progress is defined as successful completion of 30 semester credit hours or more per year. A student who fails to make normal progress toward the degree or does not maintain satisfactory academic standards may have the scholarship revoked, but may re-apply when deficiencies are corrected.

All applicants must:

- Complete the application form and submit a letter of application outlining any qualifications (honors, service, work experience, etc.) that the applicant would like to be considered by the Scholarship Committee;
- Submit an unofficial transcript of all college work; and
- Provide a 250-word essay explaining why the applicant is pursuing a degree offered in the Department of Applied Engineering and Technology.
